Each year Adopt-a-Family matches local families experiencing a financial or medical crisis with volunteer sponsors from the community seeking to experience the joy of giving. Families receive gifts for their children and a grocery card for a holiday meal.

Monthly Free Shop:

The Welcome Warehouse Free Shop offers gently-used clothing and household items to families in need living in the Dublin City School District and referred by an affiliate partner.

Hours:

9am-11am on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of each month
3:30pm-5:30pm, one Friday each month

Emergency Household Assistance:

Welcome Warehouse offers emergency financial assistance to Dublin households facing a financial crisis. Emergency Household Assistance is available for the following services:

- Utilities (gas, electric, water) (cable or internet services will not be considered)
- Phone (includes cell service if land line is not available)
- Transportation (includes gas cards, bus passes)
- Medical Equipment/Prescription Medication/Eye Glasses
- Food (grocery card)
- Welcome Warehouse DOES NOT offer rental assistance.

Food Pantry:

The Dublin Food Pantry is a "choice" pantry set-up like a grocery store; eligible clients may shop once a month and are free to select their own food within the quantity guidelines. Typical selections include canned goods, meat, fresh produce, bread/pastries, baby food/diapers, and toiletries.

Thanksgiving Assistance:

Each year the Dublin Food Pantry supports local families experiencing a financial or medical crisis during the Thanksgiving holiday. Families receive a food box with a turkey and sides to prepare a Thanksgiving meal at home.
