Board Policy 5517.01 in part states:

“Reporting Requirement

At least semi-annually, the Superintendent shall provide to the President of the Board a written summary of all reported incidents (of bullying) and post the summary on the District web site (if one exists). The list shall be limited to the number of verified acts of harassment, intimidation, and/or bullying, whether in the classroom, on school property, to and from school, or at school sponsored events.”

Written below is the Bullying Summary for the second semester of the 2016/17 school year to be posted on the web site and to submit to the Board of Education.

Report to the Board President on Bullying in the Dublin City Schools for the first semester of the 2016/17 School Year

During the second semester of the 2016/17 school year, the online reporting site received 65 reports of which five were determined to be false reports. Of the remaining 60 reports, 38 were for bullying, harassment or intimidation. Each report containing enough information was investigated and details on the action taken was entered into the Public School Works Behavior Management system. These actions could range from conferences with students involved to out of school suspensions. The bullying report breaks down into 1 elementary report, 14 middle school reports and 23 high school reports.

This system ensures we meet all of the standards of the policy and the law.
