Red Flags Program Update

An update on the Red Flags Program was presented by Mr. Jim Mauro: Executive Director, NAMI; Ms. Kathryn Mihelich-Helms: Executive Director, Dublin Counseling Center; Mr. Chris Nemeth: Dublin Counseling Center; Mr. Thom Jones: Principal, Grizzell Middle School.

Dr. Axner acknowledged and thanked Mr. Don Piunno for his efforts regarding the Red Flags program and then introduced Mr. Jim Maruo, Executive Director, NAMI of Ohio.

Mr. Maruo noted that this important mental health program has been in existence for some time, however, Dublin City Schools is the first district in Ohio to fully implement the program in all middle schools. Mr. Maruo read a letter from Justice Evelyn Lundberg Stratton, Supreme Court of Ohio. Justice Stratton commended district staff for their commitment to the Red Flags program and offered support and encouragement for continued participation in the program.

Ms. Kathryn Mihelich-Helms, Executive Director Dublin Counseling Center, thanked Dr. Axner and the board for their support of the program. Mr. Chris Nemeth (Dublin Counseling Center), and Mr. Thom Jones, Principal of Grizzell Middle School, then updated the board on program activities from the 2008/2009 school year.

Mr. Maruo presented a plaque to Dr. Axner and the board of education acknowledging the commitment and participation in the Red Flags Program.

Business Advisory Council Year End Review
