State Report Card and College Readiness Committee Update - Ms. Jamie Meade, Director of Curriculum (Data, Assessment, and Program Evaluation)

State Report Card

Ms. Jamie Meade, Director of Curriculum (Data, Assessment, and Program Evaluation) presented data regarding the district's 2008-2009 State Report Card. Ms. Meade noted that Dublin City Schools achieved the highest level "Excellent with Distinction". Ms. Meade reviewed the four accountability measures from the State Department of Education; State Achievement Indicators, Performance Index, Adequate Yearly Progress, and Value Added and then noted the district's results for each measure.

College Readiness

Ms. Meade updated the board on the initiatives to support college readiness in Dublin City Schools. The committee established goals by surveying surrounding districts, established current status of Dublin City Schools, and examining indicators of college readiness. The focus of the committee is: Identifying

and proposing educational practices within Dublin City Schools that would provide opportunity and access for all students to become college ready.

The College Readiness committee proposed the following six goals:

- Increase opportunities for students to take ACT and SAT on-site within a Dublin City School High School.
- Administer full-length ACT practice test to all juniors
- Increase teacher professional development opportunities in regard to college readiness
- Increase student preparation opportunities
- Increase PSAT participation among underclassmen
- Survey students to learn more about obstacles for college readiness preparation and participation
