2014-15 District Goal Reports

Facility Task Force

Mr. Weininger noted that the Task Force met on September 22, 2014 and discussed district construction, renovation, and project management. An architectural assessment was recommended and several firms were interviewed for this service. Garmann & Miller will be recommended to the board for this job and it is anticipated that a recommendation will be presented to the board by the end of December.

Gifted Education Task Force

Mr. Melody reported that the task force is represented by about 25 staff members and administrators from the elementary and middle school levels. The objective of the task force is to review the current service model in present populations. Members of the task force are working on ideas and strategies and would like to present them to the public at community meetings.

Middle School Schedule Task Force

Mr. Harris noted that the task force is represented by district teachers, principals and administrators. The question put to the task force is "What should a middle school student day look like in an ideal world?"

Objectives include: understanding how a middle school student learns best, reviewing the current Dublin middle school schedule, considering various middle school scheduling options, and potentially making a recommendation for a change to the current Dublin middle school schedule.

Ideas and best practices considered were:
Middle School students need choice to stay engaged
Middle School students need to feel connected and safe during the school day
Middle School students need time for related arts
Middle School students learn best in short bursts

The task force will be including input from district parents as well.

Staffing Plan Task Force

Mr. Valentine reported that the task force examined current practices and staffing needs. Staffing costs represent almost 90% of the district budget and the task force will be establishing goals to look at best practices for staffing for an increasing student enrollment.

Mr. Harris noted that the Tolles Technical Center celebrated 40 years of service to students in the area. Several superintendents including Superintendent Tolles were in attendance. A commemorative award was presented to Dublin City Schools as a participating district.

Mr. Weininger noted that he would be representing the board at the OSBA Capital Conference and requested that the board review the platform for the business meeting and let him know of any concerns.

Mr. Weininger thanked several Central Office staff members for volunteering their time for students at the Holloween Spooktacular event.
