**Student Empowerment Support Framework Update - Janet Gillig – Executive Director of Pupil Services**

Ms. Janet Gillig, Executive Director of Pupil Services updated the board of education on the restructure and repurpose of staff in the Pupil Services Department due to funding adjustments for Safe and Drug Free Programming.

A new job position “Pupil Service Support Specialist” is being recommended to the board which will replace the current Mental Health position.

Ms. Gillig then discussed the new “Student Empowerment Support Framework” and staff assignments in high schools, middle schools and elementary schools.

Dr. Axner addressed some of the concerns brought up at the June 14 board of education meeting regarding initiating the Head Start Program in Dublin City Schools.

Ms. Gillig presented highlights and provisions of the Head Start Program to the board of education.

Ms. Packer reviewed services that will be provided by Head Start for students and families participating in the program.

It was noted that enrollment will be handled strictly by the Head Start staff, and only Dublin City Schools residents will participate in the program.

Yearly evaluation of the Head Start program was also discussed.
