**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT / COMMENTS**

**Family and Civic Engagement Team – Mr. Mike Trego, Deputy Superintendent**

Mr. Mike Trego, Deputy Superintendent, updated the board on the status of implementing the Family and Civic Engagement legislation at Dublin City Schools. Mr. Trego noted that part of the implementation plan includes utilizing the current Dublin City Schools Business Advisory Council (as noted below) and adopting the proposed policy 9141 (attached).

*The Dublin City Schools will utilize the existing Dublin City Schools Business Advisory Council as our Family and Civic Engagement Team. The Dublin City Schools BAC will perform the functions of both the advisory council, under ORC 3313.82, and the Civic Engagement Team, under ORC 3313.821.*

*The membership of the BAC will include representation from the following areas to meet the expectations of the Family and Civic Engagement legislation. These members will include parents, community representatives, health and human services representatives, business representatives, and any other representatives identified by the board. The superintendent will assume the responsibility for replacing members who leave the advisory council for any reason.*

**Healthier Schools Healthier Kids Act 2010 (SB 210) Presentation – Mr. Brian Hunt, Food Services Supervisor**

Mr. Hunt discussed the affects that Ohio SB 210 and the reauthorization of the National School Lunch Program would have on participation and revenue for the food service department (Ohio SB 210 - effective June 25<sup>th</sup> 2010, National School Lunch Program – pending). Mr. Hunt presented possible financial and procedural solutions to offset cost issues due to these new government mandates.

It was noted that communication with staff, students, and parents would be key to obtain compliance with the new restrictions.
