Senate Bill 210 – Requirement for Body Mass Index (BMI) Testing (student testing) - Ms. Janet Gillig, Executive Director of Pupil Services

Ms. Janet Gillig, *Executive Director of Pupil Services*, presented an update regarding Senate Bill 210 – **Healthy Choices for Healthy Children Act** enacted on June 18, 2010.

SB 210 Provisions include:

- Combat student obesity
- Increase student physical activity
- Provide access to healthy meals/beverages at school
- Provide parents and guardians with information about student health
- Conduct Body Mass Index (BMI) Testing at Kindergarten, 3rd, 5th, and 9th grade levels

Ms. Gillig reviewed information regarding BMI testing and discussed options for the district regarding implementing the BMI portion of SB210. The district may opt to implement the BMI provision or apply for a waiver for the 2010/2011 school year.
