EL English Intermediate (907)

EL English focuses on speaking, listening, reading and writing in English for the English Learner. Emphasis is on developing a student's English proficiency using language arts content. This course is aligned to the Ohio English Language Proficiency Standards and English Language Arts Standards. EL English Intermediate further develops the students' English proficiencies as assessed and focuses on student need.

Course Goals

EL English 907 focuses on speaking, listening, reading and writing in English for the English Learner at the Intermediate language proficiency level. Emphasis is on developing a student's English proficiency using language arts content. Both courses align to Ohio's Academic Content Standards for EL and Language Arts. EL 907 further develops the specific English proficiencies as assessed for each student. Emphasis of the course is focused on the individual student need within the four major categories of study.

As students work through the learning objectives outlined in the graded course of study for English Language Learners, each course will also offer opportunities for learning from adopted language arts graded courses of study as necessary in order to assist students in bridging back to the language arts classroom as soon as possible.

 - Informational texts

 - Production (writing process)
 - Application (argument (opinion), narrative, informative/explanatory)
- Speaking and Listening
 - Comprehension and collaboration
 - Presentation
- Language
 - Vocabulary acquisition and use
 - Conventions (grammar and usage, spelling, mechanics)
