### School & District

Dublin is a rapidly growing, diverse, upper-middle class, suburban, residential community located northwest of Columbus, Ohio. The majority of the residents are professional and business people employed in Columbus. Dublin Jerome High School is a four-year high school, with an enrollment of 1,924 students in grades 9-12. In this 2021-22 school year, DJHS anticipates a graduating class of 462 students. Dublin Jerome is fully accredited by the State of Ohio Department of Education. Dublin Jerome High School has 125 certificated staff. Of these, 102 have a master's degree.

### Graduation Requirements

The curriculum at Dublin Jerome is comprehensive, including Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, honors, occupational, vocational and adjusted programs. In addition to meeting Ohio state assessment requirements, twenty-one units of credit are required for graduation. Specific requirements include 4.5 elective courses and the following:

### Honors / Advanced Placement

Honors opportunities are available in English I, II, III, Algebra II, Precalculus, Spanish IV, German IV, French IV. Advanced Placement courses are offered in English Language and Literature, Biology, Chemistry, Physics C, Physics 1, Physics 2, Environmental Science, Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, Statistics, Calculus AB and BC, United States History, European History, World History, U.S. Government, Micro & Macro Economics, Spanish, French, German, and Japanese. Transcripts are noted accordingly. In 2021, 652 students at Dublin Jerome High School took 1,337 AP Exams, resulting in the following scores:

### IB Programme

Dublin City Schools became an authorized International Baccalaureate (IB) district in February 2008. The IB Programme began at the start of the 2008-09 school year. The following IB courses are offered: Business & Management (1 yr), English HL (2 yr), English Lang & Lit (2 yr), Lit & Performance (1 yr), Spanish B SL & HL (2 yr), French B SL & HL (2 yr), Chinese SL (2 yr), Spanish Ab Initio SL (2 yr), French Ab Initio SL (2 yr), German Ab Initio SL (2 yr), Chinese Ab Initio SL (2 yr), History of the Americas HL (2 yr), Global Politics SL & HL (2 yr), Psychology SL (1 yr), Philosophy HL (2 yr), Biology HL (2 yr), Chemistry SL (2 yr), Environmental Systems & Societies SL (2 yr), Physics HL (2 yr) Math HL (2 yr), Math SL (2 yr), Math Studies SL (2 yr), Apps & Interpretation SL & HL (1 yr), Analysis & Approaches SL & HL (1 yr), Further Math HL (1 yr), Computer Science HL (2 yr), Design Technology SL (2 yr), Sports & Exercise Science SL (1 yr), Visual Arts SL & HL (2 yr), Music SL & HL (2 yr), Theatre SL & HL (2 yr), IB Diploma students must also take Theory of Knowledge and Creativity Action and Service, which are both 2-year courses.

### Weighted Grades

Honors courses receive an additional 0.5 value. Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate courses receive an additional 1.0 value. Grades of D+, or lower, do not receive the added point value. College Credit Plus (dual enrollment) courses taught through Ohio State or Columbus State also receive an additional 1.0 value.



### Scholastic Recognition

The Class of 2021 had 23 National Merit Finalists, and 12 National Merit Commended Scholars.

Dublin Jerome High School does not release standardized test scores. Students must use the official reporting services of SAT/ACT.
