In order to support the needs of our district's cognitively gifted students, we provide a Cog Pullout class for qualifying 4th and 5th grade students. The Gifted Intervention Specialist (GIS) instructs the pullout class at each elementary school. The Cog Pullout class meets each week and is structured to support cognitively gifted children with extension and enrichment activities that focus on the following areas:

- Creativity
- Collaboration and Communication
- Critical Thinking and Problem Solving
- Development of Positive Self-Awareness
- Research and Presentation Skills
